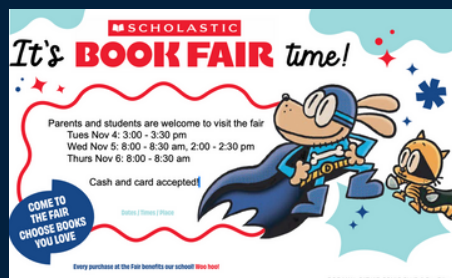

Migrant Workers Ministry is looking for parent volunteers from Sacred Heart School

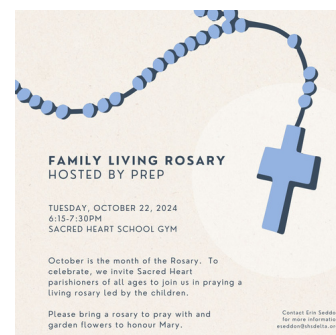
