The start of the school year gives us a good opportunity to remind everyone of some of our school and parking safety protocols:

1. All visitors to our school are required to report to the school office. If going beyond the office, please sign in and get a "Friend of Sacred Heart" badge, which must be worn for the duration of your stay at the school. When you are leaving the school, please return your badge to the office and sign out.
2. The parking area north of the crosswalk is for Kindergarten families only, (one hour before pick-up and drop-off times). Please have your K pass visible.
3. When parking on the gravel lot you must turn left (south) on a green light.
4. When in the pick-up line please remain in your car as you wait for your child.
5. On the west side of the gravel parking lot, facing Arthur Drive, please park at a 45-degree angle. On the slough side of the gravel parking lot please parallel park.

If you're coordinating a pick-up or drop-off for your child, kindly inform the person about the parking safety guidelines
