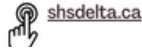

Sacred Heart School Expansion Update

Father Francis formed a Parish Building Committee at the start of the 2025-26 school year to explore expansion of the school. The Committee is working with the Archdiocese of Vancouver and the Parish on the discernment and approval process for school expansion.

Contracts have now been awarded for a geotechnical investigation and site survey. These important early steps assess soil conditions and confirm site details, helping ensure the project is planned thoughtfully, safely, and with care for the long-term needs of our students. These studies will also guide the Committee in determining building footprint, size, and design constraints.

To minimize disruption, the geotechnical investigation has been scheduled for February 12, when staff will be attending the Catholic Educators Conference. A tender call will be issued shortly to secure a project manager for the next phase of the project.

The school expansion project is grounded in the principles of Catholic education, responsible stewardship, and Augustinian values of Truth, Unity, and Love. These principles will ensure that the investments we make are financially prudent and designed to serve the spiritual, academic, and community needs of Sacred Heart Parish and School.
