Let's work together to spread warmth and smiles this winter!



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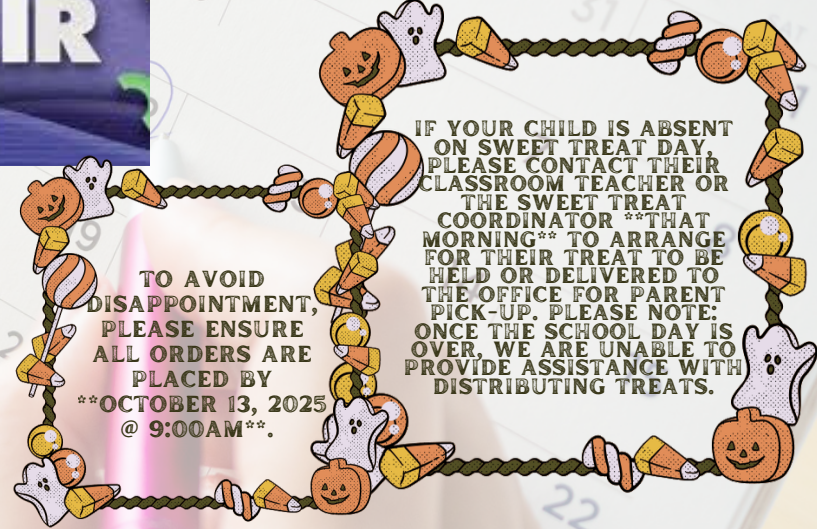


MARK YOUR CALENDAR
