<u>Carnaval, Mardi Gras at Sacred Heart School February 25, 2020:</u> It is Carnival season! The Grade 7 classes are preparing to celebrate Mardi Gras with their version of a Winter festival that is truly a Canadian experience. The Quebec Carnaval (the world's largest winter festival) and Festival du Voyageurs are two of Canada's most popular French winter celebrations. Activities from these events will be recreated through activities prepared and led by the Grade 7 classes.

What to wear? Dress like Bonhomme Carnaval (white pants and top, red tuque, colourful belt or sash), a voyageur or coureur de bois, French Canadians who were involved in the fur trade, (dark pants, long sleeve winter top, tuque, belt or sash) or les carnavaleux (winter festival goers).

What to do? Come ready to have fun and participate in your family groups at the stations designed and led by our Grade 7 students. Le Carnaval will start at approximately 9:00 am and go until 12 pm. Dismissal will be at 3 pm as usual.


