Online Registration: We will be ready to open online registration next week. An email will be sent out with registration instructions. This year all required documents for registration will be submitted electronically in attachments to our online registration. In order to complete the registration process all documents must be submitted.

To know which documents to have ready, please see the following:

- Student Birth Certificate or Passport
- Student Baptismal Certificate if Baptized
- Immunization Records if they have never been submitted
- Proof of Canadian Citizenship for one Guardian
- Proof of Lawful Admittance to Canada if applicable
- Proof of Residency Municipal Bill, Rental agreement or Utility Bill with **current** address and year.
- ID of second Guardian Birth Certificate or Passport
- Legal Orders or Agreements if applicable

Also, please have ready your Student Information Verification Form which was sent home with your child in February. This form is used to confirm that our school system information is up to date and accurate. If you have misplaced your form please email Lia Munro at <a href="mailto:office@shsdelta.org">office@shsdelta.org</a> and you will receive a new one via email.

You can also expect to find an email with information regarding next year's School Supply Lists and instructions for the purchase of School Uniforms.


Thank you for your patience. We are very excited to start the process, and look forward to our families registering for the new school year.

Sunday Reflection: God makes himself known to us. Knowing God in a way that brings eternal life is no casual acquaintance, but an intimate friendship. When we know someone as a friend, we know likes and dislikes, character and personality. God knows us intimately and, amazingly, desires to be known, and makes himself known to those created in his image. LITURGY OF THE WORD In the first reading, after Jesus' Ascension, the disciples went to the upper room and devoted themselves to prayer. In Peter's Epistle, he encourages the beloved community to rejoice in persecution; privileged to suffer with Christ, they will also glorify God. In John's Gospel, Jesus, nearing the end of his earthly life, prays for his followers who remain in the world.
