

As the Father has sent me, so I send you.

Receive the Holy Spirit.

John 20.19-23

<u>Sunday Reflection:</u> We each receive gifts from the Holy Spirit to share with others, for the greater good. Today, as we celebrate the birthday of the Church with the coming of the Holy Spirit, we also reflect on the gifts that the Spirit gives to each of us. Let us pray to be able to recognize them, and ask for the grace to use them for the sake of the Kingdom.

LITURGY OF THE WORD The first reading recounts the dramatic coming of the Holy Spirit to the disciples – and their resulting ability to speak in different tongues. In his Letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul writes that while there are different kinds of spiritual gifts, there is but the same Spirit, and the same God. In the Gospel, Jesus appears to the disciples in a locked room, gives them the Holy Spirit, and grants them the authority to forgive sins.

At our 11am Mass this Sunday, **Zhongim (Margaret) Cao, Xiaobo (Franklin) Deng and Jessica Ward** will be received into the Church through Baptism and Eucharist, Confirmation. They will now be called neophytes, literally new shoots of the vine. We offer our prayers, best wishes and congratulations to them.
